Is it working?

- Having both the whiteboard and my own iPad has been vital in modelling, not just for learners but staff too
- Learners are beginning to initiate use of app during even the most challenging of circumstances
- Learners are using TD Snap with reduced prompting, demonstrating more independence

Td Snap to be used in both Explorer and Move On Class



AAC Referrals
